Purpose

The purpose of this funding is to inspire and promote public involvement in the implementation of the Iowa City Climate Action and Adaptation Plan. Community input and involvement are crucial to reducing local greenhouse emissions in order to reach community-wide carbon reduction goals. This grant program aims to enhance local climate action through work performed by community-based organizations. The grant will fund projects that specifically promote or implement one or more of the 35 actions within the Plan.

Available Funding

The maximum amount of funding an organization can request is \$5,000.

Requirements

The organization or group must be principally and physically located in Iowa City. For-profit agencies may apply if they partner with a non-profit agency partner in the project. The goal of the grant project must align with the goals listed in Iowa City's Climate Action and Adaptation Plan.

Grant funds cannot be used for operational costs.
