
Iowa City Climate Action 2019 and Adaptation Plan





The City of Iowa City is pleased to present this update of the City's climate actions taken since the Climate Action and Adaptation Plan was adopted in September 2018.

HIGHLIGHTS of Iowa City Climate Action

September 2018

City adopted Climate Action and Adaptation Plan



October 2018

Iowa City Gateway Project—raising Dubuque Street and replacing the Park Road bridge—completed



December 2018

Larger recycling carts provided to 16,000 households with grant assistance from the Recycling Partnership. City also began rolling out larger organics carts

January 2019

Electric vehicle charging stations added to City parking ramps, bringing the total number of ramps with charging stations to five
