

Help keep roads and walks clear while avoiding fines, damage and towing



1 SHOVEL YOUR SIDEWALKS


Sidewalks must be cleared within 24-hours of a one-inch or greater snowfall.

- ❄ The entire width of the sidewalk must be cleared of snow and ice, down to the concrete.
- ❄ **Check your lease!** This may be your responsibility as the renter.
- ❄ Remember to clear curb ramps and crosswalks for wheelchairs and strollers.
- ❄ If you are leaving for an extended time, find someone to shovel your walks.
- ❄ **Fines: Upwards of \$100.**

2 DON'T GET TOWED

Cars parked on the street need to move **every 48-hours**, per City code. Snow Emergencies are called so plows can clear heavy snow and ice quickly. When this happens, on street parking is severely limited.

- ❄ Move your vehicle off of the street if you plan to leave town for more than two days.
- ❄ Learn more and how to sign up for Snow Emergency alerts at icgov.org/snow.
- ❄ If you are towed, call **319-356-5151**, or police at **319-358-5275**. Do not call 911.
- ❄ **Fines: Upwards of \$200.**



3 PREVENT FROZEN PIPES

Cold weather can freeze pipes leading to bursts that can cost thousands of dollars in damage.

- ❄ Keep the heat set to at least 55 degrees.
- ❄ Close windows, but keep doors open to rooms that contain plumbing.
- ❄ Ask a friend to check your place while you are away.
- ❄ Know where the water shutoff valve is located.
- ❄ If you have a water emergency, call **319-356-5166**.
